

Psalm 100

(Often referred to as “Old Hundredth”)

Introduction: This Psalm’s Title in the Hebrew Bible:

The two basic parts of Psalm 100 constitute Israel’s call for the universal praise of Yaweh.

- 1A. In part one Israel puts forth her *commands to praise the LORD*. (vv. 1-4)
 - 1B. Her command to acclaim Him vocally (v. 1)
 - 2B. Her command to worship Him practically (v. 2a)
 - 3B. Her command to approach Him enthusiastically (v. 2b)
 - 4B. Her command to acknowledge Him exclusively (v. 3)
 - 1C. The statement of it (v. 3a)
 - 2C. The support of it (v. 3b)
 - 5B. Her command to come into His presence gratefully (v. 4a, b)
 - 6B. Her command to thank Him specifically (v. 4c)
 - 7B. Her command to praise Him comprehensively (v. 4d)

- 2A. In part two Israel publishes her *causes for praising the LORD*. (v. 5)
 - 1B. The LORD God is supremely beneficent. (v. 5a)
 - 2B. The LORD God is forever loyal. (v. 5b)
 - 3B. The LORD God is always reliable. (v. 5c)
